SPORTS FLOOR PREPARATION

DESCRIPTION

SURFACE TREATMENT removes oily and greasy residues on sports floor. It is used in recoating system before sanding the floor. This cleaning step reduces the risk of spread contaminants on the floor during sanding process. It optimizes the adhesion of the new coat over the existing finish and prefinished floor. SURFACE TREATMENT is part of a complete finishing system for wooden sports floor ensuring compatibility and performance.

RECOMMENDED USES

Sports floors: Basketball, volleyball, raquetball, squash, badminton, training gyms, dance floors or aerobic dance floors

■ APPLICATION GUIDELINES WITH SPRAYER

NOTE: Turn off all ventilation in the gymnasium. If ventilation can not be turned off, block all ducts for a minimum of air circulation in the gymnasium.

- 1- Sweep or vacuum to remove dust, dirt and other debris. Pay special attention to corners
- 2- Spray SURFACE TREATMENT and treat the floor with a low-speed polishing machine (175 RPM) and a white pad (250 sq.ft. (23.2 m²) / side). Treat each section with SURFACE TREATMENT respecting the coverage. Do not apply an excessive amount of liquid on the floor.
- 3- Before starting another section, make sure to remove immediately any residue on the floor using wet white bath towels. Rinse the floor 1 to 2 times with warm water. Do not put dirty towels into the rinse bucket.

NOTE: Overlap sections to treat the floor completely. Pay particular attention to corners.

- 4- Once the surface is treated, allow 1 hour or until the floor is completely dry.
- 5- Sand using a 120 grit screen disc. DO NOT use steel wool. It is important to remove all traces of gloss. It is recommended to use a maroon pad (250 sq.ft. (23.2 m²) / side) after the sanding to eliminate screening marks that may appear in the final result.
NOTE: "V" grooves and hard to reach places must be hand cleaned and sanded.
- 6- Remove dust using a vacuum cleaner or slightly damp towels.
- 7- Use Finitec Expert SPORT water based recoating system (refer to *Recoating instructions for sports floor*).
- 8- Clean tools with water.

■ FIRST AID

In case of eye or skin contact, rinse well with water for 15 minutes. In case of inhalation, allow the victim to rest in a well-ventilated area. If swallowed, seek medical attention. Do not induce vomiting. Have conscious person drink several glasses of water. Keep out of reach of children.
